The Public Administration course focuses on public policy, local authority and socio-economic development. It equips the student with transferable analytical abilities, methods for in-depth understanding and the resources needed to participate in new public decision-making, in all government positions, public and parastatal organisations, at local or European level.

## ADPM2M - Information

### Learning outcomes

The Master in Public Administration offers courses based on :

- the analysis of the many different issues faced by institutions and players in the context of public policy;
- the acquisition of methods and skills to deliver effectiveness and efficiency in public sector administration;
- the modernisation and continuous assessment of change in public organizations.

In terms of professional training, this Master prepares students to take up various roles in the administration and management of public organizations, both at regional and local level as well as in bodies working in close collaboration with the public sector (e.g. political parties, trades unions and professional organizations). In addition, although the programme is not primarily aimed at the Belgian public sector, it nevertheless offers support to students wishing to prepare for certain entry examinations held by public institutions such as the government recruitment office.

Finally, this Master gives students the opportunity to develop their individual research skills. They will acquire a rigorous framework for posing questions in a field of their choice in the context of the work placement and the dissertation (professional focus).

### Teaching method

The interdisciplinary nature of the programme is reflected both in the core subjects and in the area studies.

Wide variety of **teaching strategies** (including e-learning):

- most of the teaching staff have been trained to use of modern multi-media techniques and innovations introduced at the University
- the objective of the seminars is to give students the methodological framework they will need for their individual projects, whether research or professionally based

Wide variety of **learning situations** :

- possibility of a work placement (professional focus)
- group work (core subjects as well as professional focus)

### Evaluation

It is up to each member of the teaching staff to decide on the most appropriate methods of assessment according to the objectives of the course: **oral** or **written** examinations, work to be done throughout the year (e.g. reviews of literature, case studies, essays) or **exercises**.

### Mobility and/or Internationalisation outlook

There are numerous opportunities for internships and travel abroad, in Europe or elsewhere, easing the student's integration into the workplace. Courses are also taught in foreign languages by visiting professors.

### Programme structure

The 120 Master's degree in Business Administration includes the following three elements:

- Core subjects including the dissertation (20 credits)
- A professional focus worth 30 credits, with in-depth study of the management of public organizations and public policy
- A work placement worth 10 credits which may be linked to an issue dealt with in the dissertation.

*Whatever the focus or the options chosen, the programme of this master shall totalize 120 credits, spread over two years of studies each of 60 credits.*
